MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2025-05

“CREATING A PHILHEALTH CAPITATION FUND FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE OUTPATIENT CONSULTATION AND DIAGNOSTIC BENEFIT PACKAGE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION (PHILHEALTH) FOR QUALIFIED INDIGENT FAMILIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUSTOS, BULACAN UNDER THE INDIGENT SECTOR COMPONENT OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM.”

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bustos, Bulacan in duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE – The ordinance shall be known as “The Philhealth Capitation Fund Ordinance of the Municipality of Bustos, Bulacan”.

SECTION II. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES – The creation of Philhealth Capitation Fund is additional revenue for the municipal government of Bustos, Bulacan.

SECTION III. DEFINITION OF TERMS AS USED IN THE ORDINANCE.

1. **Capitation** – a tax levied per head/a uniform fee for each several people/an individual or institution is paid a fixed per capital amount for each person served, without regard to the actual number or nature of services provided to each person

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2. **Philhealth Capitation Fund** – shall refer to the amount to be given by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation of the Local Government Unit of Bustos, Bulacan from the proceeds of the outpatient consultation done in the municipality and from diagnostic benefit package.

SECTION IV. RULES ON THE USE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSITION OF THE PHILHEALTH CAPITATION FUND

1. The capitation amount shall be released on a quarterly basis by the corporation (Philhealth) on the following:

- a. Initial released shall be subject to prior accreditation of the municipality owned and managed by the Rural Health Units and the payment premium contribution by the Municipality; and
- b. Succeeding release of quarterly capitation shall be subject to the submission of required monitoring/evaluation reports as provided for under the implementing guidelines of the Outpatient Consultation and Diagnostic package and prior payment premiums.

2. Disposition of the PCF shall be governed by the following:

- a. The disbursement and liquidation of the PCF shall be in accordance with patient government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
- b. A separate book of accounts shall maintained by the local government unit; and
- c. The capitation fund shall be used only for the specified purposes specified in the outpatient Consultation and Diagnostic Package Guidelines.

3. The corporation may withhold the release of the subsequent quarterly PCF's due to any of the following:

- a. Delay or non-payment of premium contribution;
- b. Violation of government accounting and auditing rules and regulations on the disbursement and liquidation of the PCF; and
- c. Non- submission of the required reports under item 1.2 hereof.

SECTION V. TREATMENT OF THE CAPITATION FUND

All funds generated from the capitation fund shall be treated as trust fund of the Municipal Government of Bustos, Bulacan and shall be used only for the specified purposes specified in the Outpatient Consultation and Diagnostic Package Guidelines.

- a. Sixty percent (60%) for the Operational Cost which shall cover the drugs and medicines, reagents, medical supplies, laboratory supplies, equipment, and office supplies; and
- b. Forty percent (40%) shall be exclusively utilized and honoraria of the staff of Rural Health Unit and BHW in the improvement of their capabilities to provide better health services, broken down as follows:
 - Fifty percent (50%) for the Physician/s; and
 - Thirty five (35%) other health professionals, non-health professionals staff.
 - Fifteen percent (15%) Barangay Health Workers.

SECTION VI. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – Should any provision, section or part of this ordinance be declared by any competent authorities as invalid, the remaining provision, sections, or part thereof remain to be in full force and effect.




SECTION VIII. EFFECTIVITY – This ordinance shall take effect upon the accreditation of the Municipal Health Unit as OPB provider.


